SECTION 1. G.S. 153A-122 reads as rewritten:		
"§ 153A-122. Territorial jurisdiction of county ordinances.

any ordinano	ce adopted pursuant to this Article applicable to any part of the	county not within a
city.		
<u>(b)</u> H	n addition, the The governing board of a city may by resolution	on permit a county
ordinance ad	dopted pursuant to this Article to be applicable within the city	y. <u>In the resolution</u>
permitting th	ne county ordinance to be applicable within the city, the governing	ng board of the city
may specify	that any signage required by the county ordinance be in co	mpliance with city
ordinances.	The city may by resolution withdraw its permission to such an o	ordinance. If it does
so, the city s	shall give written notice to the county of its withdrawal of permis	ssion; 30 days after
the day the	county receives this notice the county ordinance ceases to be ap	pplicable within the

city."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
