adding a new section to read:		
" <u>§ 136-276. Usage contracts.</u>		
A usage	contract entered into between the Authority and a carrier is not a public	record
within the meaning of G.S. 132-1. For purposes of this section, the term "usage contract" means		
a contract or agreement that contains terms and conditions involving terminal services related		
to maritime activities, including dockage, wharfage, cargo handling, storage, ro-ro service,		
transportation drayage, and other miscellaneous port services."		

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
