Short Title: Port Usage Contracts/Public Records. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Lee and Sanderson (Primary Sponsors). Referred to: Rules and Operations of the Senate. March 18, 2015 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A USAGE CONTRACT ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE STATE PORTS AUTHORITY AND A CARRIER IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 20 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 136-276. Usage contracts. A usage contract entered into between the Authority and a carrier is not a public record within the meaning of G.S. 132-1. For purposes of this section, the term "usage contract" means a contract or agreement that contains terms and conditions involving terminal services related to maritime activities, including dockage, wharfage, cargo handling, storage, ro-ro service, transportation drayage, and other miscellaneous port services."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
