The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 153A-98 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(c4) Even if considered part of an employee's personnel file, the following information
regarding any sworn law enforcement officer shall not be disclosed to an employee or any other
person, unless disclosed in accordance with G.S. 132-1.4, or in accordance with G.S. 132-1.10,
or for the personal safety of that sworn law enforcement officer or any other person residing in
the same residence:
(1) <u>Information that might identify the residence of a sworn law enforcement</u>
officer.
(2) Emergency contact information.
(3) Any identifying information as defined in G.S. 14-113.20."
SECTION 2. G.S. 160A-168 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(c4) Even if considered part of an employee's personnel file, the following information
regarding any sworn law enforcement officer shall not be disclosed to an employee or any other
person, unless disclosed in accordance with G.S. 132-1.4, or in accordance with G.S. 132-1.10,
or for the personal safety of that sworn law enforcement officer or any other person residing in
the same residence:
(1) <u>Information that might identify the residence of a sworn law enforcement</u>
officer.
(2) Emergency contact information.
(3) Any identifying information as defined in G.S. 14-113.20." SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2015.
