6		The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
7	SECTION 1. Article 9 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a			
8	new section to read:			
9	"§ 105-269.8. Contribution by individual for early detection of breast and cervical cancer.			
10	An individual entitled to a refund of income taxes under Part 2 of Article 4 of this Chapter			
11	may elect to contribute all or part of the refund to be used for early detection of breast and cervical			
12	cancer at the Cancer Prevention and Control Branch of the Division of Public Health of the			
13	Department of Health and Human Services. The Secretary shall provide appropriate language and			
14	space on the individual income tax form in which to make the election. The Secretary shall include			
15	in the income tax instructions an explanation that the contributions will be used for early detection			
16	of breast and cervical cancer only. The election becomes irrevocable upon filing the individual's			
17	income tax return for the taxable year.			
18	The Secretary shall transmit the contributions made pursuant to this section to the State			
19	Treasurer to be distributed for early detection of breast and cervical cancer. The State Treasurer			
20	shall distribute the contributions to the Cancer Prevention and Control Branch of the Division of			
21	Public Health of the Department of Health and Human Services. Funds distributed pursuant to this			
22	section shall be used only for early detection of breast and cervical cancer and shall be used in			
23		accordance with North Carolina's Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program's policies and		
24	procedures."			
25		SECTION 2. The General Assembly finds that the funds generated by this act ar		
26	intended to be additional funding for early detection of breast and cervical cancer and are no

27 28 29	intended to replace current appropriations for early detection of breast and cervical cancer. SECTION 3. This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1 2017, and expires for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2021.
