A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE MEANING OF RESIDE LEGALLY AS USED IN THE NOTARY  
PUBLIC STATUTES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 10B-3 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"§ 10B-3. Definitions.

The following definitions apply in this Chapter:

...

(20a) Reside legally. – A citizen of the United States or an alien lawfully admitted for  
permanent residence as defined in 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(20).

...."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
