9	to retain free of the enforcement of the claims of creditors:

11	<u>(13</u>	The debtor's aggregate interest in any lawfully possessed firearms, not to
12		exceed a total of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) in value. This exemption
13		shall apply to a total of no more than two handguns and four rifles or
14		shotguns."
15	SE	<b>CTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2017.
