2	AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT A POLICY OF			
3	ACADEMIC FREEDOM.			
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 115C-12 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:			
6	"(46) Duty to Ensure Academic Freedom. – The State Board of Education shall			
7	adopt a policy to be implemented by local boards of education to ensure			
8	academic freedom in the classroom. Nothing in the policy shall prohibit an			
9	educator from maintaining a safe and orderly classroom or a timely agenda.			
10	The policy shall include, at a minimum, the following elements:			
11		<u>a.</u>	Students and educators are encouraged to respect t	
12			political, religious, or nonreligious viewpoints held b	y all persons in
13			the classroom.	
14		<u>b.</u>	Students and educators are permitted to engage in	
15			critical thinking, and the free exchange of ideas relate	d to the content
16			of the course.	
17		<u>c.</u>	A student shall not be discriminated against or n	
18			student's ideological, political, religious, or nonreligio	
19		<u>d.</u>	An educator shall not take a student's ideological, pol-	
20			or nonreligious viewpoints into account when evaluati	ng the student's
21			performance.	
22		<u>e.</u>	Educators may answer questions posed by students	with openness
23			and honesty."	
24			This act is effective when it becomes law and applies	beginning with
25	the 2017-2018 school year.
