## SENATE SIMPLE RESOLUTION DRSR15038-RQ-1 (01/19)

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATING AN		
2	ELECTING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF		
3	NORTH CAROLINA.		
4	Be it resolved by the Senate:		
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The following procedures for nominating and electing members of the		
6	Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina are adopted:		
7	I. COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES.		
8	1. It is the duty of the Senate Select Committee on Nominations (hereinafte		
9	referred to as the "Senate Committee") to choose nominees for each opening on the Board of		
10	Governors of The University of North Carolina to which the Senate is to elect members.		
11	2. The Senate Committee shall receive suggestions of proposed nominees for		
12	election to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina from Monday, March 6,		
13	2017, through Friday, March 10, 2017. In 2017, the total number of positions available for		
14	election by the Senate is six, and each position is for a four-year term. A Senator may propose		
15	nominees only for the openings available for election by the Senate. In order for a person to have		
16	standing to be considered as a nominee by the Senate Committee, that person must be formally		
17	nominated by a member of the Senate. Only a written nomination on a form provided by the Chair		
18 19	of the Senate Committee for that purpose and received in the Office of the Senate Principal Clerk		
20	on or after Monday, March 6, 2017, and no later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, March 10, 2017, shall constitute a formal nomination of an individual Dalivary to the Office of the Senate Principal		
20	constitute a formal nomination of an individual. Delivery to the Office of the Senate Principal Clerk of a nomination form by facsimile transmission or e-mail transmission shall not constitute a		
22	formal nomination of an individual. An individual is not eligible for nomination by a member of		
23	the Senate if he or she was nominated for election to the Board of Governors by a member of the		
24	House of Representatives during the 2017 Session or was nominated for election to the Board of		
25	Governors for a vacancy for a partial term by a member of the Senate during the 2017 Session.		
26	3. Notwithstanding G.S. 138A-22, every person who has been formally nominat		
27	shall file a completed North Carolina State Ethics Commission Statement of Economic Intere-		
28	with the North Carolina State Ethics Commission to be received by the North Carolina Sta		
29	Ethics Commission no later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, March 10, 2017. The Statement		
30	Economic Interest must clearly state that the person has been nominated for the Board		
31	Governors of The University of North Carolina.		
32	4. After the close of the nomination period on March 10, 2017, the Sena		
33	Committee shall list all proposed nominees. The Senate Committee shall screen the nominees f		
34	nomination as to their qualifications and background and may interview each one to make su		
35	that suitable individuals are nominated. The Senate Committee shall ascertain that each nomin		
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for nomination is willing and able to serve and has no statutory disability. On completion of the



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1	screening process, the Senate Committee shall conduct a vote to ensure that the slate of legally		
2	qualified nominees lists no more than twice the number of nominees for the total seats open.		
3	5. The Chair of the Senate Committee shall ascertain whether the nominees for		
4 5	election by the Senate would serve if elected. Any nominee may withdraw without the approval of the sponsor		
5 6	<ul><li>6. Senate Committee nominees shall be placed before and recommended to the</li></ul>		
7	6. Senate Committee nominees shall be placed before and recommended to the Senate for election.		
8	II. ELECTIONS IN THE SENATE.		
9	1. A ballot shall be prepared under the supervision of the Chair of the Senate		
10	Committee for the use of the Senate.		
11	2. The ballot shall list only the names of those nominees proposed by the Senate		
12	Committee who have consented to run and for whom the Senate is entitled to vote. Their names		
13	shall be arranged alphabetically by surname.		
14	3. The Senate shall hold its election no later than Wednesday, March 29, 2017.		
15	Before the voting begins, the Chair of the Senate Committee shall explain the voting rules, which		
16	are:	C A	
17	(a) No nomination shall be received from the floor.		
18	(b) In order to be chosen, a nominee must receive the v	otes of a majority of all	
19	members present and voting.		
20	(c) Each member present and voting shall vote for as man	ny nominees as there are	
21	positions to be filled, and any ballot not so marked shal	l be deemed void.	
22	(d) If fewer than six nominees receive the votes of a r	5	
23	present and voting, a runoff to fill the open position		
24	conducted among the nominees who were not elected

27	(e) If there is a tie for the last position between two nomin	6	
28	the next runoff, both nominees shall be included in the

32	(f) If more than six nominees receive the votes of a r		
33	present and voting, then the six nominees receiving	the highest numbers of

35 36	4. The Senators shall proceed to mark their ballots for six persons, each to serve four-year terms. Every ballot shall be signed by the Senator casting it, and no unsigned ballots		
30 37	shall be counted.		
38	5. The Chair of the Senate Committee shall be responsible	e for canvassing the vote	
39	and declaring the results. All ballots shall be retained by the Senate Prince	-	
40	permanent records of the Senate and shall be open for immediate public inspection.		
41	6. When the Chair of the Senate Committee has determined that the Senate has		
42	chosen six persons to serve as members of the Board of Governors for terms of four years, the		
43	President of the Senate shall entertain a motion for the simultaneous election of those persons by		
44	the Senate to the indicated positions and for the indicated terms. The vote shall then be called		
45	electronically. If a majority of those voting shall vote "aye" and the vote is orally confirmed, those		
46	six persons named in the motion shall be declared to have been elected to the Board of Governors		
47	by the Senate.		
48	7. The results of the election in the Senate shall then be se	ent by Special Messenger	
40	to the House of Representatives.		
49	III. NOTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULT		

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1 When the election process is complete, the Chair of the Senate Committee shall notify 2 the Secretary of the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina of the names of the 3 persons elected by the Senate and of the term for which each person was elected.

4 **SECTION 2.** As used in this resolution, the term "Chair" means the Chair of the 5 Senate Select Committee on Nominations.

6 **SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
