## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO ALLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE
3	TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR THE LOCAL
4	GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO RETIRE WITH
5	UNREDUCED BENEFITS AFTER ACHIEVING TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF
6	CREDITABLE SERVICE AND TO MAKE CONFORMING CHANGES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.(a)</b> G.S. 135-5(a)(4) reads as rewritten:
9	"(4) Any member who is a law-enforcement officer and who (i) attains age 50 and
10	completes 15 or more years of creditable service in this capacity or who
11	capacity, (ii) attains age 55 and completes five or more years of creditable

capacity, (ii) attains age 55 and completes five or more years of creditable service in this capacity, or (iii) has completed 25 years of creditable service 12 may retire upon electronic submission or written application to the Board of 13 Trustees setting forth at what time, as of the first day of a calendar month, not 14 less than one day nor more than 120 days subsequent to the execution and filing 15 thereof, he the member desires to be retired; Provided, also, any member who 16 17 has met the conditions herein required but does not retire, and later becomes a teacher or an employee other than as a law-enforcement officer shall continue 18 to have the right to commence retirement." 19 20
