15		Federal Communications Commission as educational radio or educationa	
16		television stations, public libraries, and civil defense organizations, that have	
17		been certified by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt nonprofi	
18		organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue	
19		Code of 1954. The term also includes nonprofit entities that refurbish	
20		computers for the purpose of donating them to low-income students or
